

This survey was performed at the request of Mike Bessey of the Stimson Lumber Company to perform an exempt large lot segregation survey depicting eight lots and ascertaining the corner locations thereof, all within the south half of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of Section 31, T.28 N, H.42 E., W.M., Stevens County, Washington.
Additionally, as part of a boundary line adjustment (BLA) negotiated during the course of this survey, a portion of the Government Lot 4 is to be conveyed from Stimson Lumber Company to the adjoining land owner in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter (SE1/4SE1/4) of Section 36, T.28 N, R.41 E, WM.
The retracements [of original GLO surveysland subsequently recorded private surveys were required. (See References and Corner Notes.)
This survey was conducted using Spectar real time kinematic (RTK) Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) instruments. Unless otherwise noted all positions were measured by short baseline BaseRover RTK solutions and meet or exceed the Relative Accuracy Slandards for Land Boundary Surveys as defined in WAC 332. 130.085.
The field crew consisted of Bryce Tollon and Duston Galusha. Computing, field crew supervision and the final survey plat was executed by Grant D. Tolton, PLS.
